Congratulations! You are a graduating senior this year, and your science research project entered in the 50th State Science and Engineering Fair of Florida (SSEF), entitles you to apply to be nominated for a scholarship.

Along with this letter you will find a **Scholarship Nomination Application Form** and **Transcript Summary Form** for the scholarship nominations to be awarded at the SSEF this year. You must complete a separate application for each scholarship you are interested in pursuing. There must be an **original** Transcript Summary Form with an **official seal** for one of your applications (bring copies for the others). You will also find an application to further qualify you for the NASA Opportunity Award. Both Applications must be complete when you turn them in at the Scholarship or NASA desk before 5:00 pm on April 6, 2005.

Your completed application(s) along with the transcript(s) must be turned in when you arrive for project set-up on April 6, 2005. Turn them into the Scholarship Desk located near the registration area in the Orange County Convention Center **no later than 5:00 PM**. This year, we will be **unable** to allow you to FAX your school and try to get the necessary transcript information after you arrive.

A word of caution! If you plan to apply for these additional awards, see your guidance counselor AS SOON AS POSSIBLE!! They will help you get your transcript information quicker if you do not wait until the day before you travel to SSEF.

It will be our pleasure to meet and interview you when you come to the Scholarship Desk before 5:00 PM on April 6, 2005 at the Orange County Convention Center, Orlando. Meanwhile, if you have any questions, contact Saioa de Urquiza, Program Coordinator (surquiza@mail.ucf.edu).
